## Event objectives:

- Educate the students on ASCE, FIDIC and PEC codes of ethics and codes of conduct
- Ethical and unethical practices observation in the construction industry of Sindh, Pakistan
- Recommendations for adopted unethical practices in the light of codes
- Social and professional responsibilities of Engineers

## Event description:

A session prioritizing Professional Ethics was conducted in the department of Civil Engineering MUET, Jamshoro. The session focused on educating the students on Codes of Ethics and Codes of Conduct of Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC), ASCE and FIDIC. It also provided students with insights on Ethical and Unethical practices in the construction industry by allowing them to visit different sites all over the city and province.
